<p>Learning Aim: explore the care values that underpin current practice in health and social care</p> <p>Students will gain an understanding of how these care values are applied in health and social care settings, and their importance to work in the sector. You will apply these values in practice. Through various activities students will develop skills that will be of use in all careers in the health and social care sector. The values described in this unit may be applied to daily life, and to a variety of careers outside the health and social care sector.</p>	AP1	
<p>Learning Aim: investigate ways of empowering individuals who use health and social care services</p> <p>Students will also investigate methods used to empower individual users of health and social care services. This is important in health and social care, as it enables individuals to take control of their own care, and helps them to ensure that their specific needs are met. These methods include adapting activities and environments to meet individual needs, promoting choice, and using individuals' preferred methods of communication. Students will also investigate the importance of taking individual circumstances into account when planning care, as well as the potential difficulties involved in doing this.</p>	AP2	

<p>Learning Aim: explore the purpose, types and benefits of health promotion</p> <p>Students will explore some of the reasons why health-promotion activities are carried out, and the benefits of health-promotion work both for individuals and for the health and wellbeing of the nation as a whole. Students will also explore the different forms of health-promotion activities that are used by health care workers.</p>	AP3	
<p>Learning Aim: investigate how health risks can be addressed through health promotion</p> <p>Students will have the opportunity to explore and research an area of health risk. Students will then create materials for a health-promotion activity for a specified target group. There are many different health and wellbeing issues students might wish to investigate, and these are often related to the lifestyle choices people make.</p>	AP4
