All students have a vocabulary book which they should keep with them at all times • Checking that the appropriate equipment is brought to the language lessons, including vocabulary book, completed homework tasks and the text book where appropriate • Checking the spelling (from memory) of key words • Checking the progress of the learning of key phrases from the vocabulary book • Taking part in tropical conversations by working with the current key questions, listening to and assisting with the responses.
