<p>Good Food, Fast Food</p> <p>Re-creating the nation's favourite take away with a healthy twist and accessible recipes.</p> <p>10 weeks</p>	<p>Students will re-design and manufacture fast food recipes which takes into account multi-cultural design ideas. A range of methods, mixtures, materials and equipment are to be used to develop an outcome suitable for mass production. Whilst continuing to develop their research and evaluation skills students will be developing their skills and methods for creating a casing materials including pastries, yeast dough and using ready-made components. Students will also be given the chance to use natural casings. They will aim to make quality products and show independence through development of original ideas into their own initial and final product.</p> <p>Tasks will include disassembly, questionnaire design and use of findings, specification development, increased awareness and application of health and safety in food production (food production plans), evaluation of all products made and final design production.
